DNCG SAFETY PRINCIPLES

WHEN ON SITE YOU MUST:

- Take collective responsibility for ensuring you adhere to and positively promote identified principles
- 2. Where agreed, continue to work or learn from home
- **3.** Have seen and understood the induction information
- 4. Wear your lanyard at all times
- **5.** Adhere to social distancing requirements and markers/signs set out for you throughout all buildings, this includes evacuation assembly points, smoking shelters and queue control
- 6. Wash or sanitise your hands thoroughly and frequently
- **7.** Avoid touching your face, particularly eyes, nose and mouth
- 8. Follow 'catch it, bin it, kill it' if you cough or sneeze
- 9. Adhere to timetabling, work scheduling and appointment attendance
- **10.** Use equipment and materials provided in the interest of health and safety including; hand sanitiser, face coverings (where necessary), cleaning materials, bins
- 11. Wipe down frequently touched surfaces/equipment such as; desks, computer equipment, printers, lift buttons, vending buttons, hand tools, machinery
- 12. Stick to the left when moving around the building, this includes escalators
- **13.** Only use the lifts if you need to and where possible, use should be single occupancy
- **14.** Keep windows and doors open where possible (do not prop open fire doors), close all windows and doors as you leave the building
- **15.** Adhere to local area risk assessment control measures and those identified in the college overarching risk assessment
- **16.** Adhere to displayed room occupancy levels
- 17. Where possible, continue to use Microsoft Teams for meetings
- **18.** Where possible, avoid going to offices to discuss queries, try to do this through Microsoft Teams, email etc
- **19.** Keep furniture, equipment and machinery as per the original configuration, this includes classrooms, workshops, diners, learning resource centres and staffrooms
- **20.** Report confirmed positive test individuals or symptomatic individuals as outlined in the red box.
