

WHO WE ARE: The Humber Outreach Programme is one of 29 Uni Connect Partnerships across England, bringing together universities, schools, colleges, the Careers Enterprise Company and other local partners to offer impartial careers guidance, outreach activities, advice and information on the benefits and realities of going to college, university or undertaking an apprenticeship.

HOP's AIMS:

We are committed to supporting schools and colleges to add value, reduce duplication and address the gaps in order to:

- Equip young learners from underrepresented groups to make an informed choice about their options in relation to the full range of routes into and through higher education, including technical and apprenticeships;
- Minimise the barriers learners may face when choosing the option that will unlock their personal potential.

WHAT WE DO: Working with Years 9—13, our nationally approved progression framework, linked to the Gatsby Benchmarks, shapes the programmed of activities and resources we provide for our schools and colleges,. The framework is designed to be an impartial IAG & outreach curriculum, with learning outcomes that enable us to deliver meaningful interventions/resources and evaluate and measure the impact they are having on students decision making and preparedness for key transition points in their student journey. The programmed has been developed around five key themes:

- 1. Information, advice and guidance
- 2. Curriculum enhancement
- 3. University visits and experiences
- 4. Careers and employability
- 5. Confidence, Wellbeing and Resilience

Our Coordinators are qualified (or completing) the Level 6 Diploma in Careers Guidance and Development, therefore being to ensure that the resources and support you receive from us, are linked to your careers strategy and Compass +/other self assessment toolkits.


